

It may be thought desirable to give some proof that the mechanical equivalent of a certain quantity of heat is the same, whatever be the temperature of the substance in which the heat is contained. Such an experiment can easily be arranged by means of an ice calorimeter. If a weighed quantity of water or mercury at 80 C. be placed in an ice calorimeter, and the quantity of ice melted be observed, and if further eight times that quantity of water be taken at 10 C. and be placed in the same ice calorimeter, it will be found to melt exactly the same quantity of ice. This proves these two quantities of heat to be exactly the same, and capable of performing exactly the same amount of physical change. Measure of Work done in compressing a Gas.--The equivalence between heat and work done, which we have been considering, forms the foundation of the science of heattransfer, or, as it is more commonly called, thermo-dynamics.
